D-Day Commemoration & Flag - No doubt many of you will have seen the very poignant scenes from Normandy this week, of events commemorating the 80th anniversary of D-Day. There was a very special element to our commemorations in school too. Symbolising the journey taken by allied forces on D-Day, Chestnut Class took the commemorative flag purchased by West Dean Parish Council on their trip to France and visited the British Normandy Memorial at Ver sur Mer. This incredible place was the venue for the main remembrance event yesterday, attended by King Charles and surviving veterans of D -Day. During this period of commemoration, there is also a very powerful installation called 'Standing with Giants' at the memorial, with 1475 soldier silhouettes representing the British lives lost on 6th June 1944.

The flag returned to West Dean with Chestnut Class and was raised on the new flagpole, during a special D-Day period of reflection yesterday.

The formal consultation on whether West Dean CE Primary School should convert to an academy and join the Bishop Luffa Learning Partnership ended on the **6th June**. Sixteen responses were received; 13 people were in complete agreement with the proposal to convert, two were unsure and one person said no to the proposal. Stakeholders were given the opportunity to submit questions to the school governors and / or

attend one of two consultation meetings with Mr Williams, our school governors and senior leadership members from the Bishop Luffa Partnership. On the basis of the information received through consultation, the school is proceeding with the process of conversion and has now submitted its formal application for an academy order to the Department for Education. We will keep you fully informed of the next stages of the process as and when they happen. Thank you for your support of this important process.


